

ORDINANCE NO. 1082

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 934,
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO GRASS
AND WEEDS."

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Somerset,
and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the authority of
the same as follows:

Ordinance No. 934 was passed by the Borough Council of
the Borough of Somerset, County of Somerset, Commonwealth of
Pennsylvania, on October 6, 1967; and,

An amendment of Section 1 of said Ordinance is necessary
to clarify the intent of the original Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Somerset,
Pennsylvania, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 934, Section 1, is hereby
amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation, owning
or occupying any property within the Borough of Somerset,
shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation
whatsoever, to grow or remain upon such premises so as
to exceed a height of six (6) inches. Any grass, weeds
or other vegetation growing upon any premises in the
Borough in violation of any of the provisions of this
Section is hereby declared to be a nuisance and detri-
mental to the health, safety, cleanliness and comfort
of the inhabitants of the Borough. Provided, however,
that this Section shall not apply to tended gardens
containing vegetation which is edible or planted for
some useful or ornamental purpose which, in the opinion
of the Borough Council or any officer or employee of
the Borough designated thereby for the purpose is not
detrimental to the health, safety, cleanliness and
comfort of the inhabitants of the Borough.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 934, and all
other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith
are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
