Objective of the Somerset Borough Police Department Citizen Police Academy

The objective of this program is to develop a community understanding of the mission values and operations of the Police Department. To achieve this goal, the Citizen Police Academy was created to exclusively allow the citizens of the Somerset area and opportunity to experience the day-to-day operations of their community's Police Department.

The academy offers hands-on experiences and insight into the nature of police services in Somerset and is designed around an eight week curriculum meeting on Saturdays in a class setting.

The program includes classroom training, open discussions, multi-media presentations, demonstrations, practical exercises, and hands-on firearms familiarization.

Upon completion of the program, students will be able to demonstrate an understanding of the goals, values and operational objective of the Police Department that serves the community in which they live and work. At the completion of the program, students will be awarded certificates of attendance in a graduation ceremony held at the police station.

It is the hope of the Somerset Police Department that students graduating from the Citizen Police Academy will develop a clear understanding of the police services, assist the department in community relations and advocate in support of police sponsored activities and programs in Somerset County. The Citizen Police Academy is an 8 week program held once a week on Saturdays (excluding Easter weekend) from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the police station.
